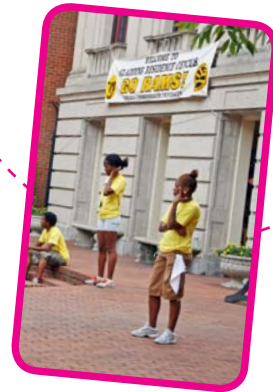

Ready, Set, Go! Opening Days

Move-in for all residence halls will take place on Saturday, Aug. 15 and Sunday, Aug. 16 from 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Please refer to the following schedule to determine your move-in day and time:

Last Names beginning...

A–G: Saturday, Aug. 15, 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

H–M: Saturday, Aug. 15, 2 – 7 p.m.

N–S: Sunday, Aug. 16, 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

T–Z: Sunday, Aug. 16, 2 – 7 p.m.

If you have an issue that prohibits you from moving in during your assigned time, the back up move-in day for everyone is Monday, Aug. 17 from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. For any other exceptions or questions, please e-mail moveinhelp@vcu.edu.

Unloading...

In order to keep the traffic moving during the move-in process, you will be directed to the most convenient unloading zone for your building. In this mailing, you will notice a color hang tag. **When you arrive, please put the hang tag on your rear view mirror so you can be identified as a VCU student who is moving into a residence hall.** The color of your hang tag corresponds with the color of the unloading zone nearest to your assigned hall. Your hang tag will serve as both your unloading zone pass and your long term parking pass. **We ask that you please DO NOT remain in an unloading zone for longer than 30 minutes.** Your adherence with the unloading zone rules is crucial to the success of move-in, and we appreciate your cooperation. After your vehicle is unloaded, you will be directed to a long term parking area. Also enclosed is a parking map, so you can get an idea of where unloading zones are located. **All locations will have a limited number of carts available for transporting your belongings, but it is a good idea to bring along a cart or hand truck if you have access to one.**



... And Parking

After your vehicle is unloaded, longer term parking will be available within two parking decks which are designated on the enclosed map. Please keep your hang tag visible so you are identified as a VCU move-in participant. Long term parking will not be permitted in the unloading zones located in front of residence halls.

Move-In Weekend

This weekend is always an exciting and energy filled event. Approximately 4,500 students will be moving onto the VCU campus over move-in weekend. While this is cause for excitement and celebration, you should also expect that there will be some long lines and maybe even some occasional confusion! We will have staff members available if you have questions or need direction, so please don't hesitate to ask.
